Il Timothy 2: 21-23 "Those who stop associating with dishonorable people will be honored. They will be set apart for the master's use, prepared to do good things. Stay away from lusts which tempt young people. Pursue what has God's approval. Pursue faith, love, and peace together with those who worship the Lord with a pure heart."

CODE OF CONDUCT

I will strive to discover my God given talents, to develop those abilities to their fullest, and to devote those talents to a lifetime of learning, serving and honoring God;

My relationships will be based on the principles of Christ and His abundant grace for me and others. I will show care and concern for myself and those who are affected by my speech and actions; (Ephesians 4:29-32 "Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers. And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice. And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.")

I will show honor for authority and submit myself to the teachers and administration of Calvary Chapel High School, realizing that attendance at CCHS is a privilege, not a right; (Hebrews 13:17 "Remember those who rule over you, who have spoken the word of God to you, whose faith follow, considering the outcome of their conduct." and I Thess. 5:12-13 "And we urge you, brethren, to recognize those who labor among you, and are over you in the Lord and admonish you, and to esteem them very highly in love for their work's sake. Be at peace among yourselves.")

I will abstain from profanity and vulgar or abusive speech and actions. Such speaking and acting are harmful to others and is certainly not appropriate nor conducive to my moral and spiritual development. (Philippians 4:8 "Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are nobel, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things." Ephesians 5:4 "It's not right that dirty stories, foolish talk, or obscene jokes should be mentioned among you either. Instead, give thanks to God."

I will abstain from sexual relations to keep myself pure before God; (Ephesians 5:3, 5 "Don't let sexual sin, perversion of any kind, or greed even be mentioned among you. This is not appropriate behavior for God's holy people. You know very well that no person who is involved in sexual sin, perversion, or greed (which means worshiping wealth) can have any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God.")

I believe that God created us male and female (Genesis 1:27 "So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.") and marriage is between a man and a woman.

I will refrain from a public display of affection on campus. I realize that I am expected to

conduct myself in a discreet and Christian manner. Therefore, while on campus, students should follow a "hands off' policy.

I will use Biblical discernment when I watch television, movies, use the computer and play games. (Psalm 101:3-7 "I will not put anything wicked in front of my eyes.

I hate what unfaithful people do; I want no part of it. I will keep far away from devious minds. I will have nothing to do with evil. I will destroy anyone who secretly slanders his neighbor. I will not tolerate anyone with a conceited look or arrogant heart. My eyes will be watching the faithful people in the land so that they may live with me. The person who lives with integrity will serve me.

The one who does deceitful things will not stay in my home. The one who tells lies will not remain in my presence. ")

I will not lie, cheat, steal or will I be associated with such behavior; I will avoid plagiarism, which is also a serious offense. (II Corinthians 8:21 "We intend to do what is right, not only in the sight of the Lord, but also in the sight of people.")

My dress and appearance will not only comply with the dress code of CCHS, but it will also reflect Christian modesty and values. (Romans 12:2 "Don't become like the people of this world. Instead, change the way you think. Then you will always be able to determine what God really wants—what is good, pleasing, and perfect.")

I will support the Word of God and the CCHS Statement of Faith as it applies to all instruction throughout the curriculum.

I will uphold this Code of Conduct at school, school activities, and outside of school.

As a parent or guardian of a student enrolled at CCHS, I will hold the student accountable to keeping this Code of Conduct and will work with CCHS in supporting my student's success.
